So our instructors take equipment for vertical caving and, if you find you are up for it once in the cave, we can get out the ropes and descend. Our instructors are extremely supportive, and we can often gently encourage people to push their limits and go further than they thought. Location:

Your caving will take place in Either the Castleton S33 8WN or Stoney Middleton (S32 3XH) areas of the Peak District based upon your booking preferences.

Equipment:

All equipment is included in the price. This includes, helmets, lights, cave suits, wellies, gloves, knee pads, harnesses and a whole range of technical and safety equipment.

What to bring:

For caving you need to wear clothes that you don't mind getting wet and potentially very dirty. Don't wear Jeans. Don't wear anything that you don't want to get destroyed. Tracksuits / with hoodies and sweaters are best. Bring a snack and a drink. Energy bars or flapjacks are best as sandwiches or pastries will get wet and squashed.
